What To Expect

While the decision on when to consider hospice care may seem overwhelming, everyone at Doctor's Hospice of Idaho strives to make the hospice referral process as accommodating as possible, anticipating your needs whenever we can and addressing all of your concerns.

The hospice referral process usually starts with a phone call to our office. While hospice care requires a doctor's order, anyone can make a referral—doctors, nurses, caregivers family, and even the patient themselves.

Once the referral is made a Doctor's Hospice of Idaho representative will meet with you to fully explain our hospice philosophy and services. We will confirm medical eligibility and insurance coverage, as well as verify patient and family preferences for palliative/hospice care.
